

# **QUESTION FOR OUR PAA AUDIENCE**

If anyone has information/experience with MR-guided Focused Ultrasound Treatment or Neuravive for patients with Tremor Dominant PD or Essential Tremors, please let Deb know. One of PAA's caregivers has asked about this treatment and we would like to get your feedback.

- FDA Approval for The Exablate Neuro is quoted as: Intended for use in the unilateral Thalamotomy treatment of idiopathic Essential Tremor patients with medication-refractory tremor. Patients must be at least age 22. The designated area in the brain responsible for the movement disorder symptoms (ventralis intermedius) must be identified and accessible for targeted thermal ablation by the Exablate device.
- Neuravive is an incisionless treatment for essential tremor patients who have not responded to medications. The treatment is performed in an MRI suite, often on an outpatient basis.
